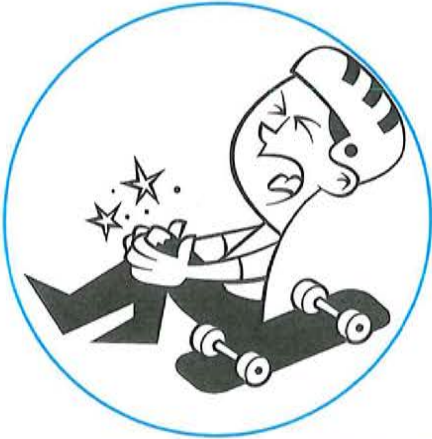
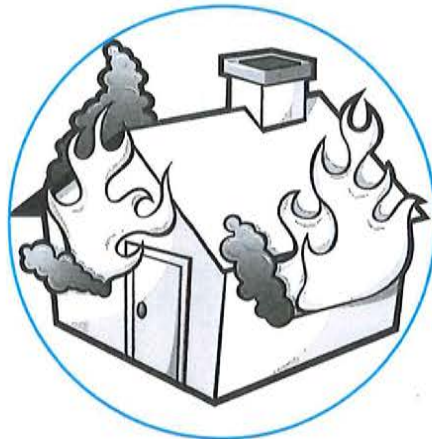


When to Call 9-1-1 for Help

A **9-1-1 emergency** is when something happens and you need the police, fire department, or an ambulance. Call 9-1-1 when you need help in a people emergency.

How to Call 9-1-1 in an Emergency

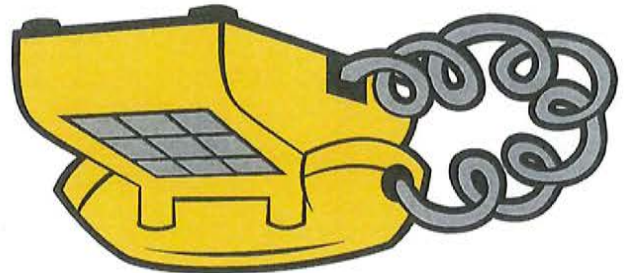
Hi, I'm Cell Phone Sally. Do you know how to get help in an emergency? Call 9-1-1. Let's learn how.

To make a book, cut along the dotted lines. Then fold the book in half two times. Read the book with your family.



Some inside phones do not have curly cords. Press the ON or TALK button. Listen for a dial tone. Then press 9-1-1. Wait for the person to answer and talk to you.

Some phones that stay indoors have curly cords. When you pick it up and you hear a dial tone, push the 9 button, push the 1 button, and then push the 1 button again. Wait for someone to answer and talk to you.

On a cell phone, press 9-1-1. Then press SEND. It may be a green button like this. Wait for someone to answer.

What to Say When You Call 9-1-1 for Help

Tips to remember if you call for help:

- * Stay calm.
- * Speak loudly and clearly.
- * Say "yes" and "no" out loud. Don't nod your head.
- * Stay on the phone until the 9-1-1 call taker tells you to hang up.

Use a different color crayon or pencil to follow each community helper through the maze. Hint: Follow the path that has items each worker needs.



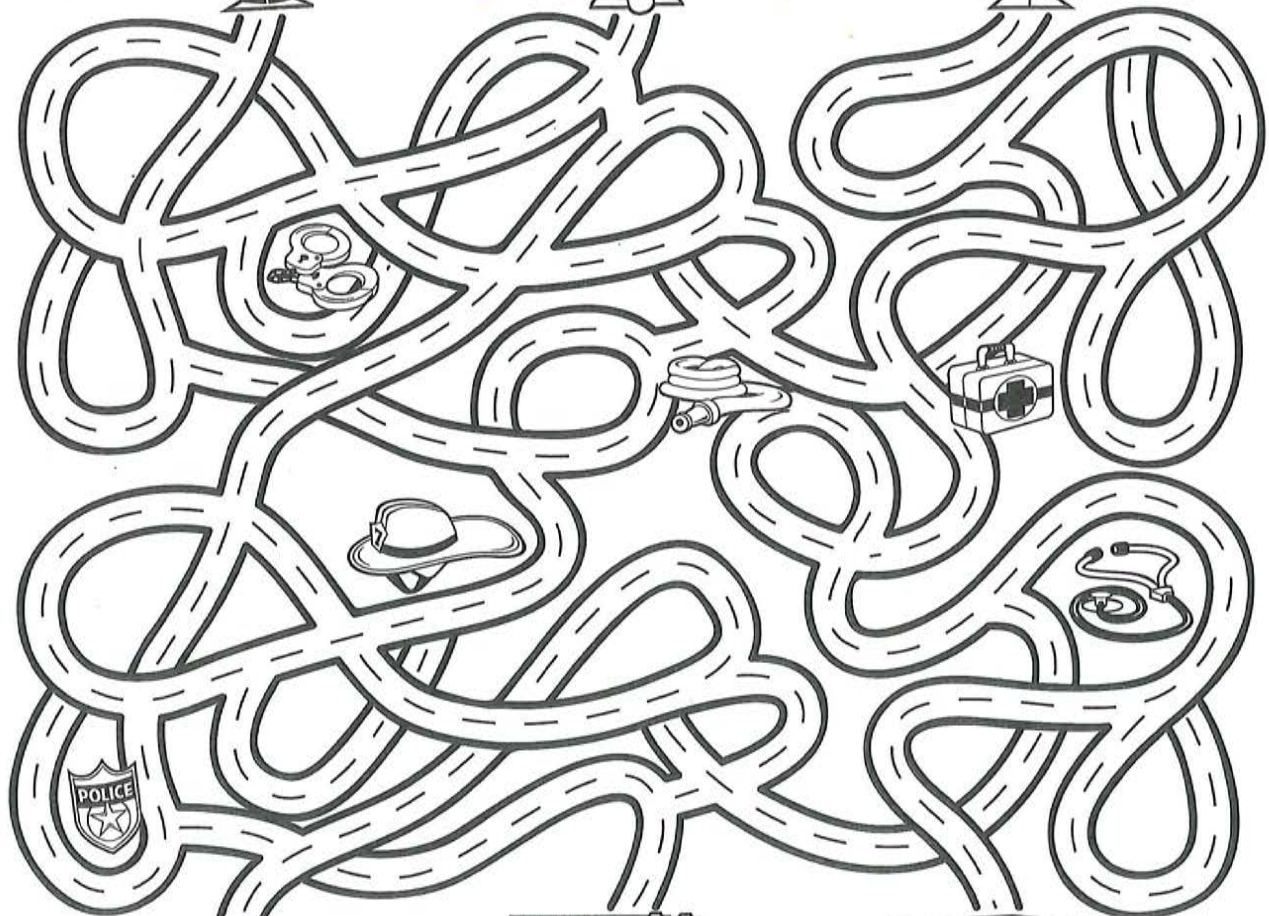
